[A.S.C.A. 32.0521(b)(c); 32.0536; 32.0559]

Exempted Employers Requiring Compliance Certificate to Verify Exemption Status with the Commission.

Exempted employers are not required by law to secure workmen's compensation coverage. This includes "minor employers" (any employer employing 2 or less employees) and employers whose rule of liability is provided by laws of the United States.

An exempted employer is still required to file a compliance certificate (or Exemption Coverage) with the Commission. The certificate serves as proof of the employer's exemption from coverage under the American Samoa Workmen's Compensation Act. Failure to file an exemption certificate is considered a violation of the compliance certificate.

Penalty | Fine:

Class A Misdemeanor - Violation of Compliance Certificate
